From the Principal

The last full month of school is upon us! As I sat down to write this, I reflected back on where we were at this time last year. About half of our students were learning virtually full-time, and about half were attending school in the hybrid model. That meant our staff was split in half, and we weren't doing much of anything extra in person.

We've come so far in a year – from having everyone back in person, to navigating changes in COVID guidelines, to what finally feels like a more typical school experience. Welcoming volunteers back to classrooms, and families back into our school for events like the art show, has been wonderful. ***I am so appreciative*** of the Jefferson community of students, families, and staff – what a great group to work with each day!

As I write this, there are 36 school days left. In May, it can feel like we are just sliding toward the end of the year. However, 36 days is 20% of the school year! ***Every day counts!*** Students are engaged in important learning every day, and we appreciate your having them here on time daily (as long as they are healthy). This month, our students in Grades 3-5 will take part in the state-mandated Smarter Balanced Assessments, along with the Washington Comprehensive Assessment of Science for fifth-graders. News from the Gym

Hello, Jefferson families, and happy May! A component of fitness that we develop in P.E. is muscular endurance. Muscular endurance is when we move our muscles over and over (12 times or more), or when we hold a position for a long time without taking a break or stopping to rest. Some exercises that strengthen muscular endurance are plank poses, sit-ups, crabwalk, bicep curls, and wall sits. Muscular endurance can help us run for longer periods of time, help us to lift and carry things over and over, as well as prevent injuries by strengthening our bones. Is there a way your child can build their muscular endurance at home?

Update on WIDA: WIDA is a new state-required assessment that replaces ELPA21. It assesses multilingual speaking students on their language acquisition and proficiency in four domains (listening, reading, writing and speaking). All multilingual language learners (MLL) students have successfully completed the WIDA assessment for language development. It was impressive to see how each student tried their very best. The guidelines for determining proficiency for exiting the multilingual program will be determined this summer. ECEAP preschool accepting applications for 2022-23



Everett Public Schools Early Childhood Education & Assistance Program (ECEAP) is a FREE preschool program for three- and four-year-old children from families with limited income. ECEAP

prepares children for kindergarten and provides family support and health and nutrition services. It is funded by the Washington State Department of Children, Youth and Families (DCYF). The six ECEAP sites within our school district are Cedar Wood, Hawthorne, Jackson, Lowell, Madison, and Silver Lake elementary schools. Students across the district are welcome to attend. Summer Academy registration is open

Registration is open for Summer Academy 2022 and [registration materials are online](#). The elementary and middle school summer academies are available for current students in kindergarten through seventh grade to reinforce learning in reading, writing, and mathematics. Priority enrollment will be given to students who meet eligibility requirements. A variety of summer academy courses are available for high school students including district-facilitated credit recovery courses, Online High School and career exploration, mentorship, and internship opportunities through Everett Career Link. Tuition is waived for EPS students for elementary, middle and high school (including OnlineHS.net courses) students.
